

Special Session of General Conference

The General Conference of the United Methodist Church is the top policy making body of the denomination. A Special Session of the General Conference took place this past week in St. Louis, Missouri. The purpose of the conference was to receive and act on a report from the Commission on a Way Forward. The Commission was authorized to examine paragraphs in The Book of Discipline concerning human sexuality and to explore options to strengthen church unity.

The Commission presented three plans on which the General Conference voted. A variation of the Traditionalist Plan was adopted by a vote of 438 to 384. Parts of the plan have been referred to the Judicial Council to determine if they are constitutional.

Please remain in prayer as we move forward and as our denomination remains divided. We continue to seek unity in Christ and trust the Hoy Spirit to continue to work to bring healing and hope. Please know that we will continue to welcome all people and we will continue to affirm the sacred worth of all people including lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender and queer persons.

The Augusta District will host a **debriefing at Greensboro First UMC**, **South Campus**, **March 17 at 4:00 p.m.** Delegates to General Conference will present an official report. Their report will help us understand what impact the decisions made will have upon our congregation. All members are invited to attend.
